## "SO, HOW DO YOU DO IT?"

A woman came up to me after the 11:00 a.m. Mass last Sunday and asked, "So, how do you guys do it?"

She had just attended the Mass and was now switching gears to witness the baptism for her cute little grandson, "Leonardo." She told me she lives on the south side of Chicago and traveled across town for this special day. By the joy in her eyes, and the excitement in her voice, I knew that she would not miss this day for anything.

"What do you mean?" I asked her. (I learned in the seminary that sometimes it is good to answer a question, with a question, when you're not exactly sure what is being asked of you. It buys you a little time.)

She answered with, "How do you get all these people to come here on Sunday? I noticed that you got young families with little kids. You got single young adults, and you got people my age. Where I come from, we don't have this many people at Mass. How do you guys do it?"

In the back of my mind, I was glad to know that her first impressions about our parish was a positive one. Yet, I also sensed that there was something much deeper spiritually churning inside her heart. It was obvious that she just had a good experience of "church."

Spiritual writers often call this an "Ah-ha Moment." It's a moment when a person experiences a sudden insight or discovery. It's when you are simply inspired by the very presence of God. Some folks have described it as having their breath taken away because they are overwhelmed by wonder and awe. Plus, this epiphany can even have a lasting effect on them.

"Well, we work really hard at it." I told the grandmother. "My staff and parishioners work hard at being a welcoming and friendly place where people can feel right at home. Like our Taco Fiesta today, we offer a lot of hospitality to help folks form relationships and build a sense of community. We try to make Mass meaningful for folks, with good music and a hopefully a 'decent' homily. It's important that when people leave church on Sunday, that they are filled with hope that will carry them through their week. I think that is how we do it. When you put it all together, it seems to work."

My conversation with the visiting grandmother reminded me of how hungry people are for a good experience of prayer, community, and church.

Catholics today will "shop around" to find a parish that fits best for them. That never bothered me because I always remind myself that we all have the "same Jesus" anyway. I totally understand the need for someone to go to a church where they feel that they are being spiritually fed.

If you are reading this, thank you for making Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph your spiritual home. Thank you for all the times you come in-person to pray with us on Sunday. Your presence in church is a precious gift to me and certainly to those sitting next to you in the pew.



I think even Jesus would agree that nobody likes a boring parish.



# Have you considered a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)?

A QCD gift (a.k.a. IRA charitable rollover) allows individuals age 70½ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to make a direct transfer of funds from their IRA to qualified charities, tax-free. This way of giving does not generate taxable income, which may lower your annual income level. If you are age 72 or older, the amount you transfer may count towards your required minimum distribution.

# What is a Mass Intention?

Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph parish offers the possibility for you to request that a Mass be celebrated for a particular intention. Requesting a Mass intention means that you are asking that the grace of Christ's sacrifice in his death and resurrection be applied for a particular purpose, for example, for a deceased person or a living person who is ill or in thanksgiving for a favor received. An intention can also be made for an occasion of a birthday, anniversary or special need, or it can be directed to a cause, such as an increase of vocations or respect for life. Usually, a single intention is attached to a given Mass. But it is also possible to gather several intentions in one Mass with exactly the same effect.
