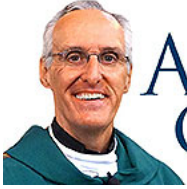

There is a great quote about those who work in the field of education. It goes like this:

*"Good Teachers, Teach.
Great Teachers, Inspire."*

This is so true. Hopefully, at one time in our life, we have been blessed by having a great teacher who inspired us, and even shaped and formed us into the person we are today.

My best teachers in grammar school, high school and college were creative and passionate. It was obvious that their heart was totally into what they were trying to accomplish in the classroom. Plus, they had the natural ability to bring out the best in their students.

Great teachers spark your imagination and make you think. They might even inspire you to dream of doing extraordinary things. They gently nudge you out of comfort zone.

My best teachers never wanted their students to just memorize information and spit it back out on a test. Anyone can do that. Instead they were more concerned that their students could understand how the things they were learning actually applied to their real life.

This Sunday, throughout the United States, Catholic parishes in each diocese celebrate "Catechetical Sunday."

We pray for and ask for God's blessings upon all those who share in the important work of teaching and passing our faith onto our children. They give of themselves in a generous way to help others open their hearts to Christ. Their dedication and example of faith is an inspiration to all of us.

Let us pray for our students, parents and families on this Catechetical Sunday. We are reminded that parents are the primary teachers of their children in faith and we pray that they may joyfully fulfill this responsibility. Parents need to be actively engaged in the education and Christian formation of their children. This is so important especially as we face the challenges of living in a very secular world.

Young parents need our support, and they need to see us living out our faith every day. We are all invited to give a powerful witness to our Catholic faith that will hopefully inspire our children. This can have a huge impact on their spiritual life for years to come.

COULD YOU BE THE ONE?



Recent studies, in the past couple of years, have shown that there is an increase in the number of people, particularly young people, who have no religious affiliation. The term "NONES" is used to refer to those who are unaffiliated with any organized religion. NONES derives from surveys of religious affiliation, in which "None" or "None of the above" is typically the last choice taken on a survey.

One sobering statistic is that 50% of Catholics, 30 years and younger, have left the church. Half the kids we baptize and confirm in the last 30 years are now ex-Catholics or unaffiliated to a particular religion. One out of six millennials in the U.S. is now a former Catholic.

For every one person joining our church today, 6.45 are leaving. And most are leaving at young ages, primarily before the age of 23. The median age of those who leave is 13.

One very interesting fact about NONES is that most are ambivalent to religion, rather than hostile to it. (This information was taken from the article in the National Catholic Reporter magazine, entitled: **“Catholic Church Should Focus On Getting ‘NONES’ Back, Bishop Barron Says,”** -June 12, 2020)

Could you be the one who brings someone back to the church? Maybe the first step is just to tell them what you appreciate about the Catholic church? Share with them why you chose to continue to practice your faith, and why it is important to you.

Then... invite them to sit next to you in the pew on Sunday.

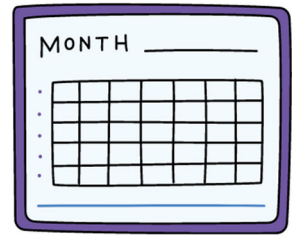

Have you considered a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)?

A QCD gift (a.k.a. IRA charitable rollover) allows individuals age 70½ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to make a direct transfer of funds from their IRA to qualified charities, tax-free. This way of giving does not generate taxable income, which may lower your annual income level. If you are age 72 or older, the amount you transfer may count towards your required minimum distribution.

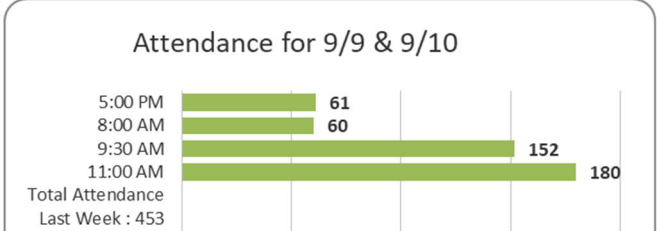
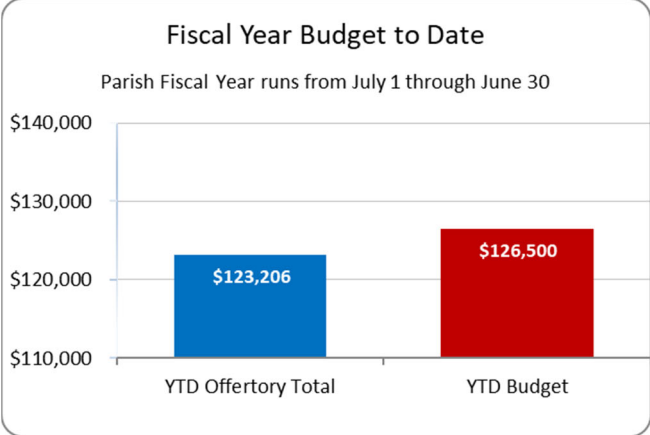
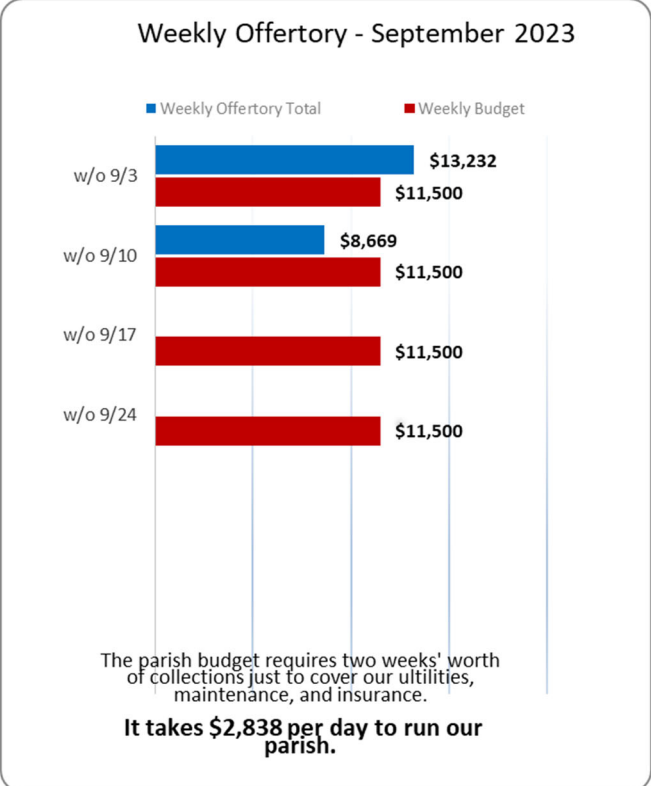

What is a Mass Intention?

Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph parish offers the possibility for you to request that a Mass be celebrated for a particular intention. Requesting a Mass intention means that you are asking that the grace of Christ's sacrifice in his death and resurrection be applied for a particular purpose, for example, for a deceased person or a living person who is ill or in thanksgiving for a favor received. An intention can also be made for an occasion of a birthday, anniversary or special need, or it can be directed to a cause, such as an increase of vocations or respect for life. Usually, a single intention is attached to a given Mass. But it is also possible to gather several intentions in one Mass with exactly the same effect.
